
## WILLIAMS PANTYCELYN


## STORIES SET FORTH WITH FAIR WORDS

THE EVOLUTION OF MEDIEVAL ROMANCE IN ICELAND

**Marianne E. Kalinke**

This book deals with the origin and development of popular literary romance in medieval Iceland. Translations of French romances, featuring knights and ladies, combat at arms, dragons and giants, were imported to Iceland towards the end of the thirteenth century. This study attests to the role played by the epic poems in the composition of romance in Iceland, which introduced the motifs of the aggressive female wooer and of Christian-heathen conflict.
